The *Community Eye Health Journal* is published quarterly by the International Centre for Eye Health, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, London. The journal addresses the control of avoidable blindness and focuses on low- and middle-income countries, where the challenges are greater.

The principal aim of the journal is educational, to ensure that up-to-date and relevant information reaches eye care workers at all levels, from community eye care workers through to ophthalmologists working in teaching hospitals. The journal is in a reader-friendly format that can be adapted for teaching or training. It is provided **free of charge** to over 25,000 readers in 179 low- and middle-income countries. For many of these readers, the journal is their only source of accurate and up-to-date information.

The journal is also produced in French, Portuguese, Spanish and Chinese. Articles are selected from the main English edition for translation.
