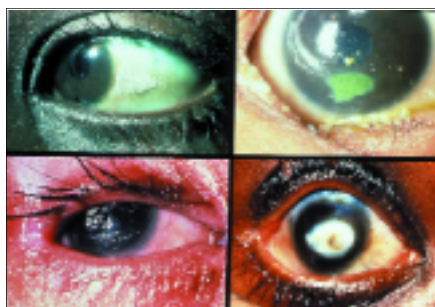

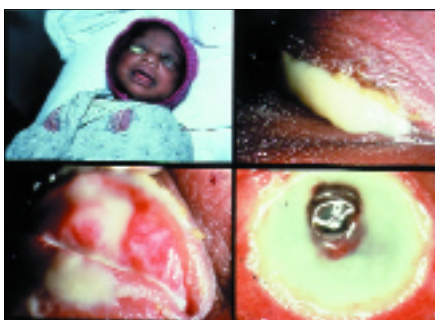
Vitamin A deficiency

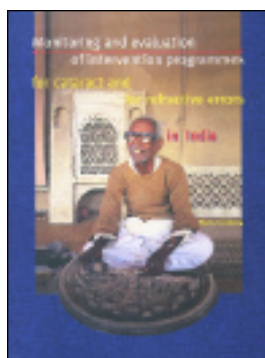
